INTRANSMACH, the joint Bulgarian-Hungarian company is involved in the design, assembly, supply, installment and commissioning of complex automated high shelving store houses, transport & distribution systems and in-plant transport.

Eng. ALEXANDAR BORISLAVOV IOTZOV has worked at INTRANSMACH from 18.04.1988 to 02.02.1990 as a leader of a group of service experts with the Technical Service Bureau at Assembly Supervision and Technical Service Laboratory Department. His duties during that period covered organization, management and direct supervision over the service maintenance of freely programmable controllers, control computers, personal computers, video terminals, relay contactor automatics and electronic regulators.

Eng. Iotzov's profound knowledge in the field of microprocessor engineering and software, electronics and electrical engineering, organization, financing and technology of servicing allowed him to build up a well functioning workshop for multiple services. His knowledge contributed much in the design, construction and commissioning of a low-speed network of the type Monoring for information exchange between professional computers of the type IBM XT and their compatibles.

On the grounds of observations on the operation of relay contactor automatics and claims made, in June 1989 eng. Iotzov elaborated new logical controls for the operation of the transportation sector handing over transported units to a distributing trolley under automatic control. On the basis of this new algorithm he invented a device using a different combination of gauges thus increasing the reliability and relieving considerably service maintenance.
